

## HOW TO TAKE CARE OF YOUR KEEPER

### Body ( Out casing)

- Soak soft cloth in warm water with mild dishwasher detergent. Wring the cloth dry and then wipe off the dirt on the outer casing of Keeper.
  - Use dried soft cloth to wipe off moisture on the outer casing of Keeper.
- ※ Be noted that the out casing of the Keeper can not be washed with water. It may cause rust.

### Inner Tank

- Fill the inner tank with clean water and use a soft sponge to wash the inner tank thoroughly.
- Pour out the water in the tank.
- Wipe off the moisture in the inner tank and air dry it. (Do not close the covers when air dry the inner tank)

### WHEN CLEANING THE KEEPER

Please read this manual thoroughly before clean your Keeper.

- Do not use chlorine type bleach. It may cause rust or pinholes on the tank.
- Do not clean with thinner, benzene, abrasive cleaners or other harsh cleaners.
- Do not wash the whole Keeper with water. It may cause rust on the outer casing.
- Make sure to clean the inner tank thoroughly. Wipe the Keeper with a dry cloth and allow all the parts to air dry before storage.

## BEFORE CONTACT OUR SERVICE CENTER

Please check your Keeper before you contact our service center. If what you encountered is not described below, please contact our service center.

SYMPTOM	CHECK POINT	WAYS TO HANDLE WITH

	Is the tap well installed?	Reinstall the tap and make sure the tap nut is tightly fastened.

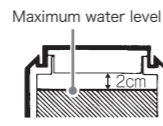
## IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

- Do not use this Keeper for any purpose other than keeping beverages hot or cold.

- Do not wash the keeper thoroughly. It may cause rust on the outer casing of the keeper.



- Please refer to below drawing for the maximum level of beverage. ( About 2cm below the inner cover)



- Avoid dropping, hitting or strong shock again the keeper. It may damage the keeper, cause deformation and leakage.



- Do not fill the keeper with beverages when carrying the product around by car. It may stain the interior of your car.



- Do not place near heat sources such as gas stoves, ovens, etc. It may cause deformation or discoloration of the product.



- Keep out of reach of children. There is risk of burn or injury.



This product should not be filled with any of the following items:

- Dry ice or beverages containing carbon dioxide**  
The pressure inside the product will increase, causing the cover set hard to open or the beverage to spout out and possibly cause injuries.
- Miso soup or other beverages containing salt**  
The salt will stick to the sides of the inner bottle and cause rust.
- Milk based beverages or fruit beverages**  
Prolonged storage may spoil the beverages. This will increase the pressure inside the product and cause the beverage to spout out and possibly cause injuries.
- Fruit pulp, tea or other kinds of leaves**  
These may clog the tap and possible malfunctions.
- Please clean your keeper after every use when filled with sports drinks.**  
Rinse the inner tank as soon as possible after use to prevent rust or pinholes.



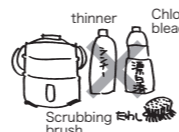
- SUFFOCATION WARNING PLASTIC BAGS**  
Keep the plastic bag away from babies and children. Do not use in cribs, beds, carriages or playpens. The plastic bag may cling to nose and mouth and cause suffocating.

- Do not use the keeper near electric appliances such as PC, digital camera, etc. Leakage of the beverage may damage your belongings.

- Do not take the product apart for repairing. It may cause damage or accident.

## SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

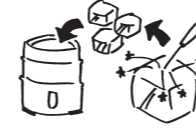
- Do not clean the product with thinner, benzene, chemical dustcloth, chlorine bleach, scrubbing brush, detergents/bleach other than dishwashing liquids. It may cause rust or malfunction.



- Do not fill the tank with fresh fruits, tea leaves or any solid particles. It may block up the tap.



- While putting ice cubes into the tank, please pour beverage first and then put small ice cubes in the tank gently. To avoid deformation of the tank or malfunction of the product.



- After pouring from the tap, small water drips might remain in the tap. To avoid stain your belongings, place a cup under the spout to avoid the remained water drips from dripping off from the tap.



- Do not keep the beverage in the tank for a long time. may spoil the beverage.



- After using the Keeper, clean and dry the tank well without closing the inner/outer cover. If the beverage remains in the tank for a long time, it may cause discoloration, bad smell, or damage of the tank.



- Do not sit on the product. Do not put something heavy on the product. It may injure yourself or cause malfunction of the product.



- While carrying or cleaning the keeper, be careful with the handle of the keeper. It may pinch your finger.



- When using the keeper, open the cover as little as possible in order keep the best hot or cold retention.

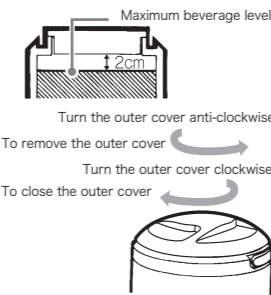
- Due to the temperature difference between inner tank and outer casing, there will maybe condensed water on the outer casing when using the keeper.

## HOW TO USE

Please clean the inner tank, outer cover, cups and inner cover thoroughly before use.

### 1 Pour beverage into the inner tank

- Turn the outer cover anti-clockwise, then remove Cup (S)/(L) and the inner cover.
- Maximum beverage level as illustrated.
- Set the inner cover and Cup (S)/(L) back to the keeper after filling the tank with beverage.
- Close the outer cover by turning it clockwise.



### 2 When dispensing beverages

- Pull the tap lever forward toward your body when dispensing beverage.



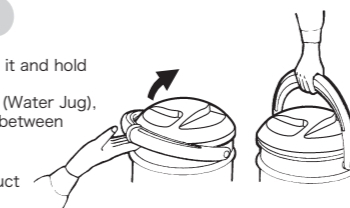
### 3 After dispensing the beverage

- Raise up the tap lever as illustrated after dispensing the beverage



### 4 When carrying the Keeper

- Raise the handle from the middle part of it and hold it firmly.  
\* While holding the handle of the Keeper (Water Jug), be careful not to sandwich your hands between the handle and the product.
- Prevent an impact or shock on the product when lifting or carrying the Keeper, in order to avoid burns.
- Place the keeper on a steady place to prevent it from falling down.

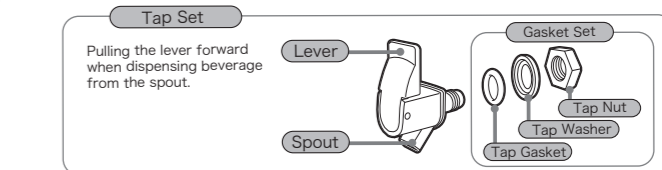
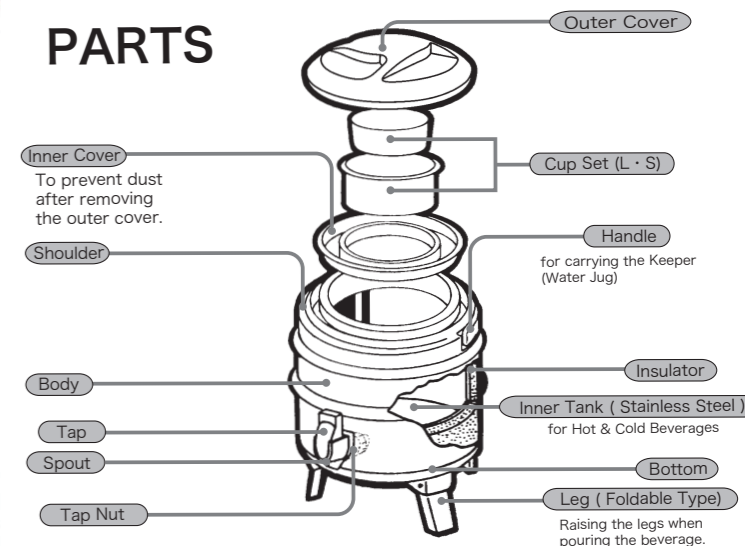
